Dear Parents / Guardians,

As our graduating cohort is in the midst of their Primary School Leaving Examination (PSLE), we are heartened to see that they have shown good discipline and resilience. As we endeavour to complete the academic term on a positive note, we encourage all students to embrace a positive mindset for learning and growth. We are pleased to provide an update of an overview of upcoming events and activities.

### **1. UPCOMING EVENTS**

#### **1.1 Children's Day Celebration**

This year, the school will celebrate Children's Day on Thu 6 Oct 2022. The theme of our Children's Day celebration is "Colours of YNPS" which aims to foster greater sense of school pride through the house system. The day will be filled with fun-filled activities such as a torch relay to kick start the house relay games, dance and music performances by teachers, recess activities by PSG and interhouse games and activities. We want to encourage our students to come to school in their PE shirts and shorts that day. There will be staggered dismissal at 1.20p.m. for P1 and P2 students and 1.30p.m. for P3 to P6 students.

Lessons are as usual from 8.30a.m. to 11.30a.m., so students will need to bring their relevant learning materials. P3 and P4 students, please bring colour pencils for a few of the activities.

In support of the student's voice, a student preference survey was carried out in Term 3 to allow students to vote for their Children's Day gift. The highest voted item is selected as their gift.

### **1.2 End-of-Year Oral Examinations**


## 2. IMPORTANT DATES TO NOTE
