NATIONAL DAY CELEBRATION 2023

1. We will be commemorating our 58th National Day on **Tuesday, 8 August 2023.**
2. The theme for this year's National Day is "***Onward As One***", which is a call for all Singaporeans to look forward confidently and move onward together in building our shared future as one united people. "Onward" reflects a nation that is forward looking and resilient to any challenges that lie ahead. "As One", underscores the collective ownership of Singapore's future and the importance of inclusivity and unity.
3. School will begin as usual at 7.30 am and will end at 10.30am. Students will be dismissed from 10.20am (P1s and P2s) and at 10.30am for the other levels at their respective gates. Students are strongly encouraged to bring along a more substantial snack to be consumed during their snack break in class. The canteen will not be opened on that day. Students are to come dressed in their red YNPS T-shirt or any other red t-shirt with school bottom and school shoes.
